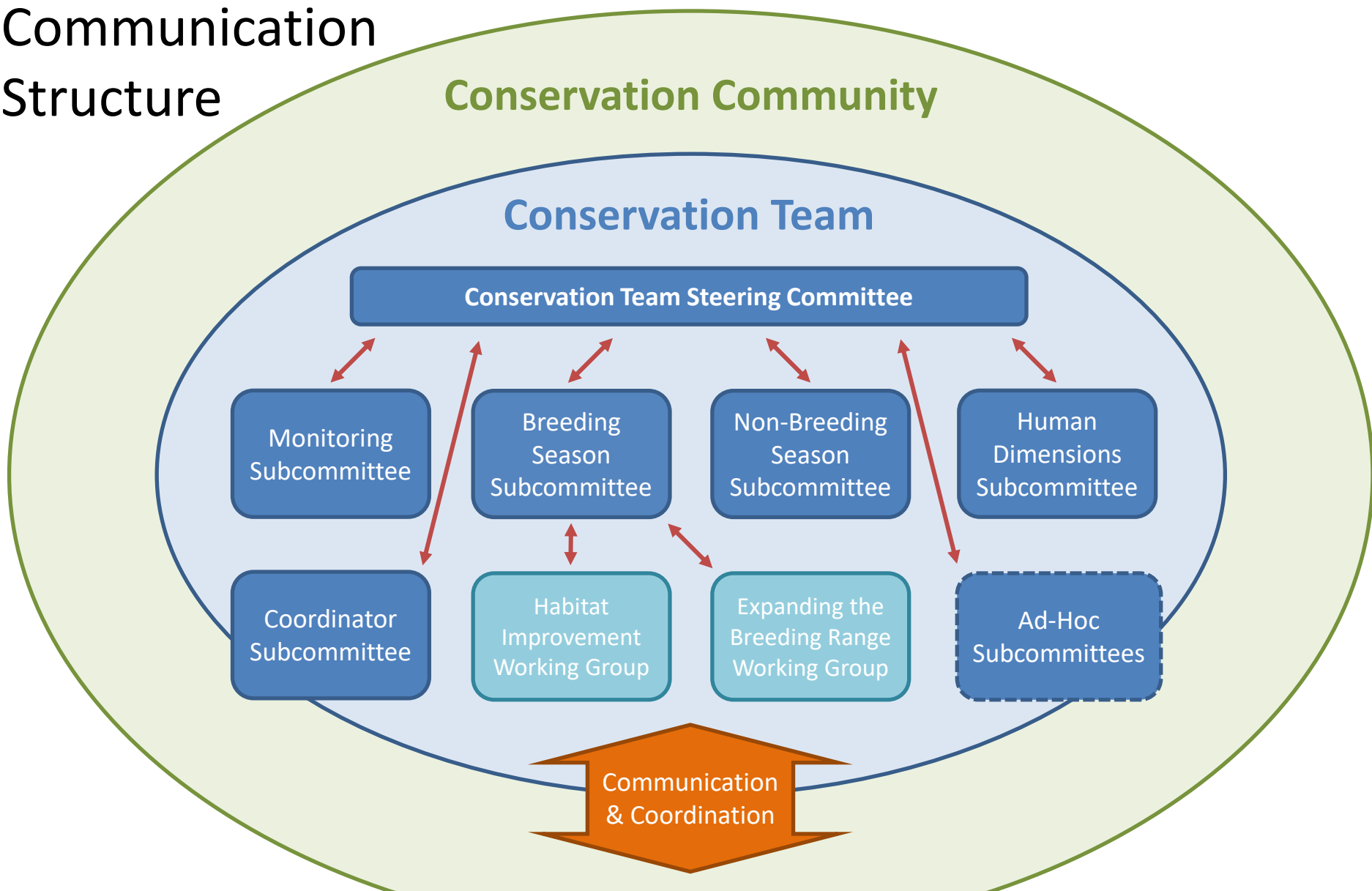


# Communication Structure
